Collage:

- Inspiration: Japanese Nōtans & Surrealism
- <u>Assignments</u>: Nōtan collages; Surrealist-inspired magazine collage
- <u>Emphasis</u>: balance, positive/negative space, scale, composition, layering images, unity, safety habits



Painting:

- <u>Inspiration</u>: Impressionists, Post-Impressionists
